## ZINNIA LILLIPUT

If you are looking for a bright colourful flower to add to your summer garden, Zinnia is the one for you. This quick growing annual has compact fully double daisy-like flowers which sits on top of upright stems. Zinnia is easy to grow, undemanding and great as a cut flower. They are great for beginner gardeners

Best time to sow:	Warm zones – Winter to late Summer, Cool & temperate zones – Spring & early Summer
Best in:	Flower patches, vegie gardens and pots
Where to grow:	Full Sun
Time to flower:	10 - 12 weeks



### PLANTING TIPS

- Zinnia love to grow in a warm, sunny and wind-sheltered spot.

### GROWING GUIDELINES

- Keep soil moist after planting and seeds will germinate within 7-10 days.
